ACCESS POINTS AND AMENITIES



Esom Hill

West on US-278 from Cedartown near highway mile marker 1. Turn south on Hardin Road. Trailhead is one-half mile on right.

Amenities: parking, horse trailer parking, Concessions two blocks south.



State Line Gateway Park

Park vehicles at Esom Hill Trailhead and go 0.3 miles west. Amenities: picnicking, lightning shelter.

The Chief Ladiga Trail in Alabama

The Chief Ladiga Trail is a 33-mile paved trail stretching from the Alabama-Georgia state line to Anniston, Alabama. The Chief Ladiga is on the same rail corridor as the Silver Comet Trail. It travels west to Piedmont then on to Jacksonville and Weaver before ending in Anniston, Alabama. It travels through beautiful wetlands, across streams, through forests and farmlands, and affords incredible views of the Talledega mountains. There are several new and restored railroad trestles just west of the Georgia state line. For more information on this trail please visit: www.trailsexpress.com.
